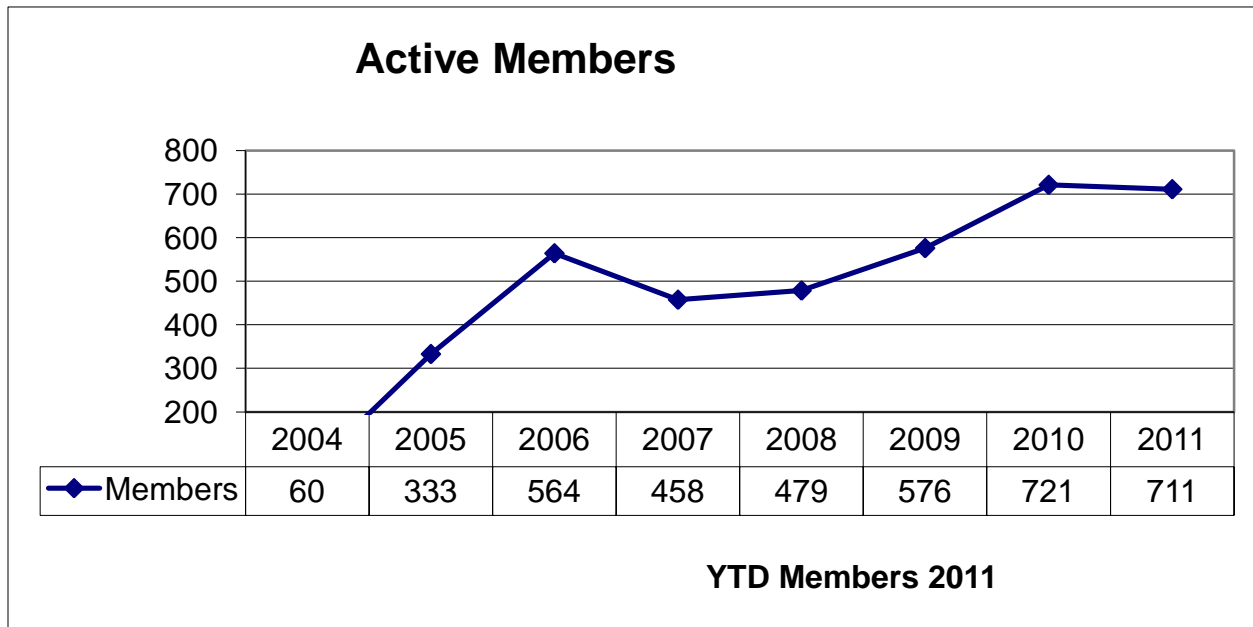
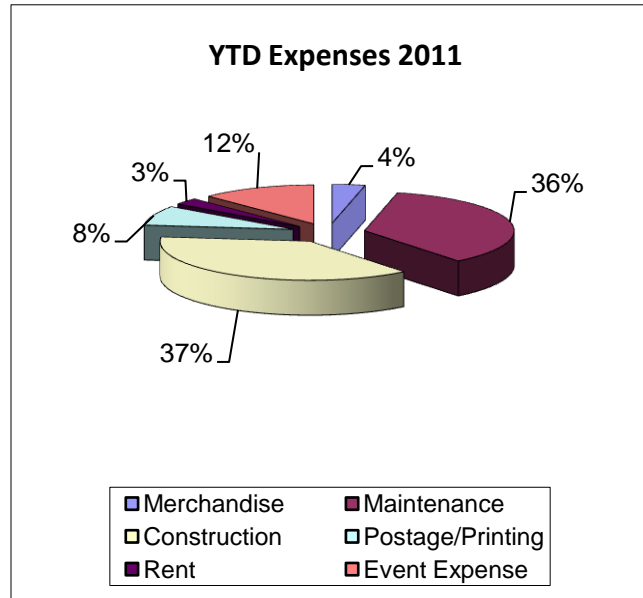
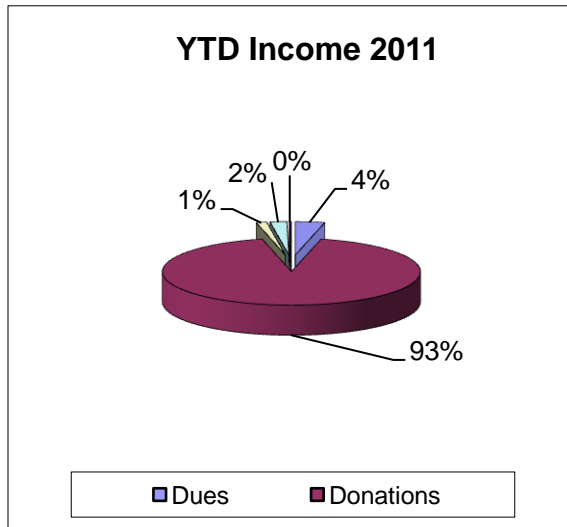

FINANCE

Costs of materials and fuel have increased park maintenance costs, primarily seen with wood chip spreading and mowing. We have also added construction and maintenance costs for Kane Dog Park (Hockinson) and water at Stevenson Dog Park (Washougal), which we are still accepting donations for. There is also added cost for additional benches that were added to various parks. We raised \$1,000 for local K9 Police this summer in memory of Kane. We have installed increased signage promoting DOGPAW dog parks.

DEVELOPMENT

Kane Dog Park (Hockinson) opened in February – we still need to work on keeping weeds at bay and to finish the last stretch of trail. Water was installed at Stevenson Dog Park (Washougal). Also, we have added more park amenities (benches, water, etc). We are still working with the Boy Scouts on amenity projects.

MEMBERSHIP

We have paid-to-date (active) members are stabilized near 700, installed signage about DOGPAW dog parks, combined lure coursing with cleanup and membership drive, and utilized social media to reach a wider audience. Only a small percent of park visitors are members and we need to improve upon that.

SAFETY

Provide the [Clark County Off-Leash Area Guide](#) online, we hand-out "safety reminder" cards to park visitors, safety signs at our parks, tips via monthly eNews for our members, in the spring we performed the [P.E.P. Talk "Dog Park Doos and Don'ts!"](#)

ADHOC

At various parks, we have rotated membership drives with lure coursing. During and prior to events we have scheduled cleanup parties to spruce-up.

In June, we had a very rainy and successful Dog Days of Summer event where we raised funds in memory of K9 Kane. We are also planning an upcoming [Dogtoberfest event \(Oct 22\)](#). Please join us, as vendors, visitors, volunteers, and donors!
